FIDIC CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION – RED BOOK 2017

This **updated FIDIC training course** is an essential knowledge development opportunity for all those practitioners, who are involved (or about to be involved) in preparation and management of FIDIC Construction (“Red Book 2017”) contracts. The main focus is on the particularities of the most traditional FIDIC contract, from preparation through tendering and the project implementation phase – elaborating on the details of available best practices.

This updated course will address mainly the features of the **2017 Red Book edition**. The focus covers also not just the differences in comparison with the other contract types by FIDIC, but also those new features, which are introduced in the 2017 second edition. In addition to the lecture-type sessions, cases and exercises will also help the participants to deepen their knowledge. Questions & answers sessions offer good opportunity for the participants to link the theoretical backgrounds introduced by the trainer with their everyday experience, and challenges they face in their projects.
